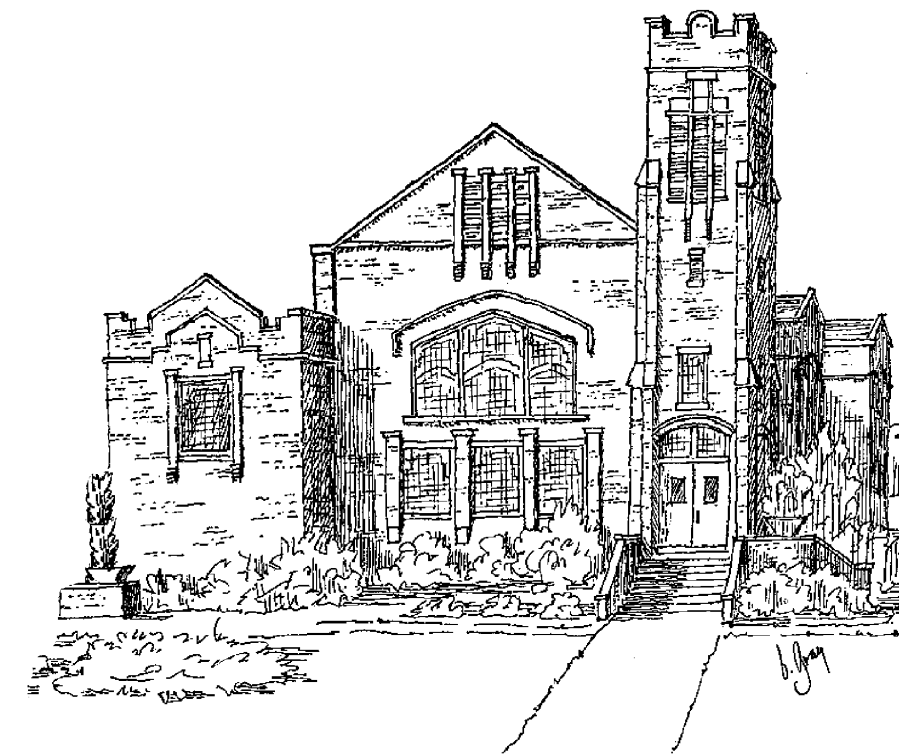
YOUTH NEWS!

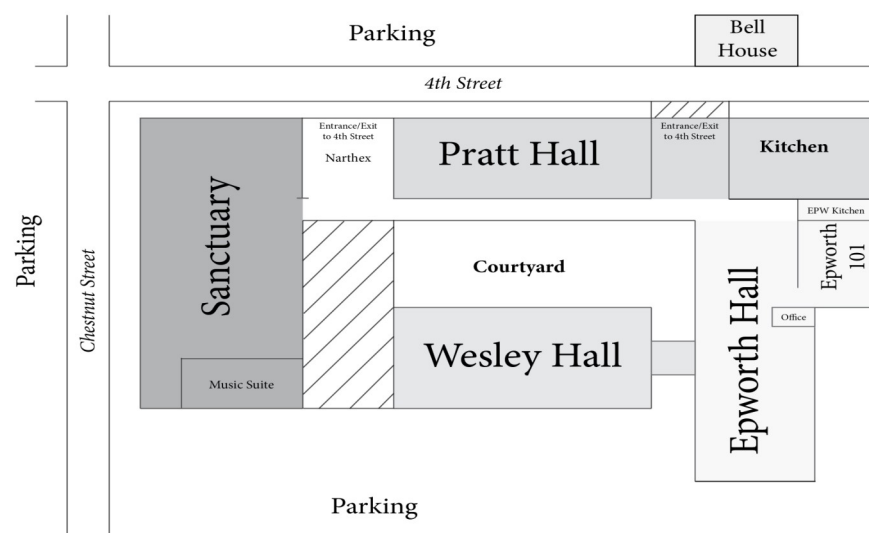
