

Nicaragua Mission Trip - Construction of houses, distribution of food bags, projects with children of the Nicaragua Children's Home

Commonly Asked Questions:

Who may join the team?

Anyone over the age of 18 may join. Minors 16 and older may join the team with a parent or guardian.

Do I need to have construction skills?

No - There is plenty to do without knowing how to build anything.

Is there anything to do besides construction?

Yes - We need people who want to play or do projects with children.

How much do I have to pay?

We ask each team member to be responsible for paying \$1000, but scholarship opportunities are available. This amount covers your room and board in country and airfare.

How much additional money do I need take?

You are responsible for any souvenirs that you may purchase in the market and any additional activity that you may want to do. \$100-\$200 should be more than enough. The Nicaraguan Cordoba is the official currency, but US dollars are accepted everywhere.

What is the commitment required for team preparation?

The Nicaragua team meets once a month to share a meal and fellowship. Team meetings are a time for team building, information and decision making. Team members should plan on attendance at every meeting.

When do I need to have a firm commitment?

Approximately the first week in January, 2018, a non-refundable deposit of \$200 will be due. Payment to cover airfare will be due approximately mid-March.

Do I need a passport?

Yes. You will need a current passport. You will also need a physician's release form to be signed by your physician. This generally requires some vaccinations for first time team members.

What is El Ayudante?

El Ayudante is a Christian organization which works through community leaders to provide opportunities to those who would not otherwise be so blessed. They also operate the Nicaragua Children's Home, which currently serves approximately 35 children. Visit their website to see the amazing things happening at El Ayudante.
